VACATION ARRANGEMENTS 2023/24

Student visa holders can work unlimited full-time hours during the vacation periods noted below, depending on the level of their course of study. Please note that some students with a January start date may have a non-standard holiday pattern and they can request a letter from their academic department. Students can prove their right to work by supplying this letter as well as the following:

- Student status letter
- Confirmation of award or their final results letter - this will show that they have completed their studies
- Their share code proving their right to work

WORKING PERMISONS – CHRISTMAS VACATION 2023/24

Undergraduate students – full-time 18 December 2023 – 07 January 2024 (inclusive)

Postgraduate students – full-time 18 December 2023 – 07 January 2024 (inclusive)

PhD Students can only work full-time during University closure dates at <https://www.strath.ac.uk/keydates/2023-24/>.

WORKING PERMISONS – SPRING VACATION 2024

Undergraduate students – full-time 01 April 2024 – 14 April 2024 (inclusive)

Postgraduate students – full-time 01 April 2024 – 14 April 2024 (inclusive)

PhD Students are restricted to 20 hours per week during this vacation period.

WORKING PERMISONS – SUMMER VACATION 2024

Undergraduate students – full-time 20 May 2024 – 15 September 2024 (inclusive) Postgraduate and PhD students are restricted to 20 hours per week during this vacation period.

WORKING FULL-TIME ON COMPLETION OF STUDIES

Students with a Tier 4 or Student visa type can also work full-time until the end of their visa if their results notification letter confirms their studies are complete.
